In order to successfully capture the correct plays for the highlight video, Video Graphics Inc. relies on time code numbers. To get accurate time code numbers, please put each game tape into your VCR, rewind it to the beginning, eject the tape, then push it back into your VCR. This should start your hours/minutes/seconds counter on the front of your VCR to 0:00:00. As you view your tape, write down the counter number at the beginning of the play you wish to transfer (called the In Point), then the number at the end of the play (called the Out Point). For games on DVD, the counter on the front of your DVD player will show the correct time code while the DVD plays. Please include a short description of the play as well so we may be sure we have the correct play. (ex. In Point: 0:42:13 to Out Point 0:42:25 - Touchdown Play).
